"The God of the Bible"

1. - his WILL for all (17)
2. - his LOVE for everyone..... (18)
3. - his PATIENCE towards everyone (19-21)
4. - his AUTHORITY over all (22)

Objective: Consider the example of Jesus to be followed in establishing his kingdom.

Icebreaker:

What is easier or more natural for you: to follow or lead?

To Start:

1. - Let us briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from last Sunday's teaching on "Semilla Online", 1 Peter 3:17-22.
2. - Let's review this week's memorization together and then two or three volunteers say our memory verses.

To Observe:

1. - According to verse 17, there are two kinds of sufferings; with which of these is the will of God associated? Let's read and talk.
2. - Let's ask the journalistic questions to verse 18, and let's talk.
3. - What can we learn in verses 19 to 21 about the patience of God?
4. - What happened to Jesus after his resurrection from the dead (vs.21b)? Let's read and discuss verse 22.

For Reflection:

1. - What is your first reaction when you suffer injustice?
2. - When was the last time you expressed God's love (selfless and sacrificial) for someone who could not reciprocate?
3. - Considering the patience that God has had with you, with whom could you be more patient this week?
4. - What does it mean for you today to know that Jesus is Lord of everything and over everyone?
