"God's Grace"

- 1) Comes from Heaven (vs 14-15)
- 2) Dignifies (vs 16-18)
- 3) Is not cheap (vs 19-23)
- 4) Makes us responsible (vs 24-27)
- 5) Is inexhaustible (vs 28-30)

Objective: To reflect on the grace of God according to the teachings of Jesus.

Icebreaker: Have you ever been entrusted with something of great value? Please share.

To Start:

1. Let's review the memory verse Matthew 7:21
2. Let's briefly share some of our notes and/or our reflections derived from this weekend's teaching in Matthew 25:14-30

To Observe a little and think a little more:

1. How many acts of grace from the man towards his servants can you count throughout this passage? Let's read together and make our list while the moderator takes notes and then read all our observations to the group.

2. What effects of *Grace* on the first two servants can you observe throughout this parable? Let's each comment on our observations.

3. Let's make a profile of the useless servant observing all the details of his character and behavior while the moderator takes notes.

4. Let's each make an explanatory paraphrase of verse 29 so that a person who has never read the Bible can understand.

To Reflect:

1. Judging from the fruit in your life, would you say that you have known the grace of God?
2. What could be preventing you from not only receiving it but even more, manifesting it in obedience and service to God? Let's brainstorm.
3. What things, people, resources, etc. has God entrusted to you that you need to pay more attention to by taking responsibility for?
