To Reflect:

1. How does the fact that the Old Testament prophecies have been fulfilled in Jesus Christ make you feel? Uncomfortable, insecure, happy, reinvigorated, hopeful, doubtful, other?
2. How should your way of thinking and living change knowing that for God all people are important and very valuable?
3. When it comes to serving God, what is the first thing that comes to mind: your ability, your talent, your resources, the power of God, the call of God, another?
4. How would you like God to use you at that moment?
